HOW TO EAT LIKE A LOCAL!



1. FASHIONABLY LATE? MORE LIKE BARCELONA TIME!

In Barcelona, the night is still young when the clock strikes 8 PM! Locals start dinner around 9 PM or even later. So, don't be in a rush—grab a vermouth or a tapa to keep the hunger at bay!

2. THE TAPAS TANGO: SHARE THE LOVE!

Tapas are all about sharing! When the plates hit the table, feel free to dive in and try a bit of everything. It's a communal experience—just make sure you leave enough for everyone to enjoy and try not to double dip.

3. WHERE'S THE BILL? WAVE FOR LA CUENTA!

Don't sit there wondering where your bill is! When you're ready to pay, make eye contact with your server and confidently ask: "La cuenta, por favor!" Often times they won't bring it unless you ask! The universal air checkmark also works.

4. COFFEE CONUNDRUM: CAFÉ SOLO OR WITH MILK?

After your meal, the coffee order matters! If you want a strong shot of espresso, ask for "un café solo". Feeling creamy? Go for "un cortado" (espresso with a splash of milk) or "un café con leche" for a milky finish!

5. PAELLA PANIC? LUNCH, NOT DINNER!

Craving paella? It's traditionally eaten at lunch in Spain! You will often find paella on Thursdays lunch menu. While you can find it on dinner menus, locals stick to the heavier rice dish during the day. For dinner, consider lighter fare like tapas or seafood.

6. CLINKING GLASSES? SAY 'SALUD!' FIRST!

Whether it's a glass of cava or a cold cerveza, don't forget to make eye contact when toasting and say "¡Salud!" before taking that first sip. Bonus points if you clink everyone's glass at the table and then gently tap the table with the bottom of your glass.

7. THE POWER OF TWO: FORK & KNIFE DANCE!"

Spanish dining etiquette is all about using both your knife and fork. Cut your food with your knife in the right hand and hold your fork in the left—then dig in! It's the classic two-hand dance of a true local.

8. RELAX, YOU'RE IN SPAIN: MEALS ARE FOR SAVORING!

Don't rush your meal! In Barcelona, dining is an experience, not a quick pit stop. Put the phone awaym enjoy the flavors, the company, and the atmosphere—long lunches and leisurely dinners are part of the local charm!

9. ON A BUDGET? GO FOR A "MENU DEL DIA"!

Most places serve a Menu of the Day Monday through Friday at lunchtime. This usually means a starter, main, drink and dessert for around 15-20 euros.
